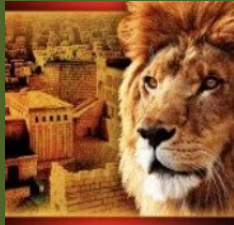

<sup>1</sup> There are a total of 24 priestly courses that the priests are divided up into. Each course is 8 days in duration (going from Sabbath to Sabbath), and is served in twice per year by the priests. This covers 48 weeks out of the year. In addition to this, all of the courses/groups serve together at the 3 annual pilgrimage feasts.

<sup>2</sup> For astronomical dating use the year -3 (rather than 4 bce) and -2 (rather than 3 bce).

<sup>3</sup> From the time the sperm attaches to the egg to the time that the egg is actually fertilized/conceived can take up to 10 days. Zechar'yahu had his vision during the 8<sup>th</sup> course, then upon completing his course of service likely had relations with Elisheva (Elizabeth) soon thereafter (sometime during the 9<sup>th</sup> course) causing Yehochanan to be conceived within that 10 day time limit, and very likely on the very day of Shavuot, which that year fell in the middle of the 10<sup>th</sup> course of service.

<sup>4</sup> The astronomical September date is likewise, -2/09/11 and formatted as (year/month/day).
