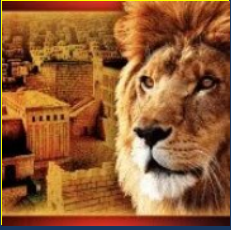

*1 JC dates are by Julian calendar, and one year less than the BC calendar. For example, 5 BC would be -4 JC when using astronomical software, and 4 BC would be -3 JC, and so on. And likewise, -3 JC would be the year 4 BC of the Gregorian calendar. BC/AD dates do not include a year 0, and so slightly complicate chronological calculation; as such the Julian/Astronomical dates which include a year 0 are preferred for chronological dating. For example, normally 3 + 27 would = 30, but on a BC/AD calendar 3 BC + 27 AD years would only add up to 29 years because BC/AD dates go from 1 BC to 1 AD with no year 0. But with Julian/Astronomical dating 3 JC + 27 AD years = 30 years because JC to AD dates go from -1 JC to 0 (or -0) JC to 1 AD.

*2 There are a total of 24 priestly courses that the priests are divided up into and beginning the 1st Sabbath following Shimini Atzeret (the 8th day following the 7th day of Sukkot). Each course is 8 days in duration (going from Sabbath to Sabbath), and is served in twice per year by the priests. This covers 48 weeks out of the year. In addition to this, all of the courses serve together during the 3 pilgrimage feasts of the year for a total of 52 weeks.

*3 From the time the sperm attaches to the egg to the time that the egg is actually fertilized/conceived can take up to 10 days. Zechar'yahu (Zechariah) had his vision during the 8th course (the course of Abia/Abiyah), then upon completing his course of service likely had relations with Elisheva (Elizabeth) sometime during the 9th course (M-y 27th to Jun. 3rd that year) causing Yehochanan (John) to be conceived within that 10 day time frame on Shavuot (Pentecost) occurring Jun. 11th that year if he had relations with Elisheva (Elizabeth) on Jun. 1st or later.
