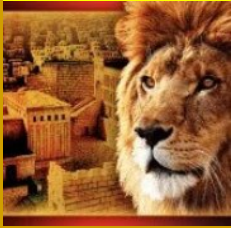

<p>14th of Aviv Pesach <i>Unleavened Bread eaten with Lamb.</i></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Pesach. 2. Leaven is removed from house. 3. First day of eight where haMatzot (Unleavened Bread) is eaten. 4. Lamb killed at setting of sun at dusk, and roasted and consumed with HaMatzot with family in privacy of the home. 5. <i>It is night of (beginning of) the 14th and Israelites are forbidden to leave homes until morning.</i> 6. All first born killed that night who did not have blood on doorposts. 7. Lamb consumed before dawn and all leftover lamb burned in morning. 8. Flocks, herds and people gathered in preparation to flee Egypt. 9. Israelites plunder Egyptians. 10. Israel is led first in the daylight with pillar of cloud, then led that following night with a pillar of fire. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. V'yikra (Leviticus) 23:5; 2. V'yikra (Leviticus) 23:6,7; 2. <i>Shemot (Exodus) 12:17; B'midbar (Numbers) 33:3</i> 3. <i>D'varim (Deuteronomy) 16:1</i> 	<p>DAY 2</p>
<p>16th of Aviv (Day 2) <i>No leaven eaten</i></p>	<p>2nd day of haMatzot (Unleavened Bread)</p>	<p>V'yikra (Leviticus) 23:6;</p>	<p>DAY 3</p>
<p>17th of Aviv (Day 3) <i>No leaven eaten</i></p>	<p>3rd day of haMatzot (Unleavened Bread)</p>	<p>V'yikra (Leviticus) 23:6;</p>	<p>DAY 4</p>

<p>21st of Aviv (Day 7 of the Appointed Time of haMatzot) <i>No leaven eaten</i></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 7th day of haMatzot (Unleavened Bread) and Day of Public Assembly 2. Eighth day out of eight where haMatzot (Unleavened Bread) has been eaten. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. V'yikra (Leviticus) 23:6,8; 2. Shemot (Exodus) 12:18; 	<p>DAY 8</p>
